How to Enter a NNGA Tournament.

1

There are three (3) ways to enter a NNGA tournament.

1. **Use this booklet.** Find a tournament you want to play, go to the page with the entry form, cut it out, fill it in, and mail it with payment to the address on the form. Please print clearly and fill out all information. We are not responsible for the timely delivery of the USP mail or other couriers. No special mail handling please, such as return receipt or signature required.

2. **Go to www.nnga.org** and click on the schedule of your choice. The information about the tournament is linked to the name of the tournament. You will find a form that you can print out and mail with payment to:

NNGA P.O. Box 5607 Reno NV 89513. This is not an online sign up.

3. **Online credit card sign up.** The NNGA is using PayPal as a secure form of online payments. We are able to accept more types of payments by using PayPal. There is a surcharge per person for credit card usage and is included in the online sign up price. Hint, if you're on the deadline date when you decide to enter; credit card is the sure way.

NNGA Code of Conduct

Also adopted by NSGA

All players in Northern Nevada Golf Association (NNGA) events shall abide by the code of conduct set by the Tournament Players Committee (TPC). Players are to conduct themselves in a manner that is conducive to sportsman like play. There are two types of penalties:

1. Major Offense Penalty
2. Minor Offense Penalty

1. Major Offense Penalty: Immediate disqualification from the tournament.
 - a. Destruction of Golf Course property
 - b. Throwing of clubs in anger
 - c. Physical or verbal abuse of a competitor, opponent or NNGA rules official or volunteer
 - d. Excessive outbursts of anger or verbal tirades causing disruption to the competitors or opponent

Any Major Offense Penalty committed receives an immediate disqualification from the tournament. (*cont.*)

New for 2010***The Dayton Valley Net Championship***

This inaugural tournament will be played April 23-26, 2010 at Dayton Valley GC and will consist entirely of net play in three divisions (regular net, senior blue net, and senior silver net). There will be two days of stroke play on April 23 & 24 followed by a 32 player cut. The remaining 32 players (16 regular net, 8 senior blue net, & 8 senior silver net) will proceed with match play on April 25 & 26. The overall regular net champion will receive their entry fee into the Northern Nevada Amateur tournament. The overall senior blue net champion and senior silver net champion will receive their entry fee into the Northern Nevada Senior Amateur tournament. Check the NNGA website for more details.

6-Man Team Championship

The 6-man Team Championship will be played on Genoa Lakes GC both days in 2010. The format will continue to be net stableford with 5 best scores of 6 counting towards your team score. (+7 d. eagle, +5 eagle, +3 birdie, +1 par, -1 bogey, -3 d. bogey +

NNGA Handicap Revision Dates

Starting January 1st, 2010 NNGA handicaps revisions will take place on the 1st and 15th of every month. See website for more information. NNGA season starts March 1 and ends November 15.

NNGA Code of Conduct

First Offense: Disqualification from the tournament. The player will receive by registered mail a letter from the TPC stating the cause of disqualification from the tournament proper and the player's letter will remain on file for a period of 12 months.

Second Offense: Disqualification from the tournament. The player will receive by registered mail a letter and a suspension from all NNGA events including Nevada State Events that will be conducted during the suspension period of 3 months from the date of the disqualification. The letter shall remain on file for a period of 15 months.

Third Offense: Disqualification from the tournament. The player will receive by registered mail a letter and a suspension from all NNGA events including Nevada State Events that will be conducted during the suspension period of 12 months from the date of the disqualification. The letter shall remain on file for a period of 24 months.

Fourth Offense: Disqualification from the tournament. The player will receive by registered mail a letter and a suspension from all NNGA events including Nevada State Events. The player will not be allowed to enter NNGA or NSGA events from the NNGA office for an indefinite period of time. *(cont.)*

Recourse for the player: Players will be allowed to have the disqualification reviewed by the TPC and will have the opportunity to address the TPC personally. The player must address the TPC personally and letters to the TPC will not be used for review. If there is no challenge the TPC ruling stands.

2. Minor Offense Penalty; Warning.

- a. Excessive offensive language.
- b. Slamming clubs or bags.
- c. Excessive display of anger or disruptive behavior.

Procedure for minor offense:

- a. Complaint from players or witnessed by NNGA official or volunteer.
- b. Player will be warned, and reminded that this is not acceptable for NNGA events.
- c. 2nd complaint in same tournament will be treated as a major offense and the player will be disqualified.

Adopted by the Tournament Players Committee and the Northern Nevada Golf Association Board of Directors October 22, 2006. Adopted by the Nevada State Golf Association for all state events October 21, 2008

Match Play Qualifying

Scratch and Net Divisions (16 players from both divisions): Points begin with the 2009 Capital City Classic and end with the 2010 2 Man Stableford. The top 8 in points and the last year winner are automatically qualified. The Match Play Qualifier tournament will determine the remaining qualifiers for both divisions. Qualifier entry fees must be submitted with entry into the Capital City Classic. When successfully qualified, the balance of tournament fees will be due by deadline (see website). *Exempt players* must declare they will participate by May 17th and tournament fees are due by deadline. If you do not declare by May 17th your spot will go to the qualifier. Qualifier players will receive entry information at the end of the qualifier. Fees must be paid by the deadline for both exempt and qualifying players. If not paid by deadline, the open spot will go to the next alternate.

Please Read !!!! State Amateur and Mid Amateur withdrawal policy Please Read !!!!

Players that withdraw from the Nevada State Amateur and Mid Amateur will not receive a refund for their entry fees, unless the hosting association has a waiting list that can be used to fill that vacancy. 72 hours before the tournament the hosting association is not required to; but may attempt to fill the vacancy.

State Qualifiers

The Nevada State Amateur and State Match play require that non-exempt players for state events enter a qualifier. The NNGA runs state qualifier events in conjunction with existing tournaments. See the 2010 schedule for qualifier tournaments.

Please read this before entering the State Match Play

There is no longer a stand-by waiting list. As of 12:00 noon the day before the event, a player who does not withdraw before the 12:00 noon deadline it will be considered as a loss of match and his opponent shall continue to the next match. ***In addition to the loss of match, the improper withdrawal from the match play will result in the forfeiture of next years eligibility.***

State Amateur Qualifying

Scratch and Net Divisions (30 players for each division from each association) Points begin with the 2009 Reno/Sparks City Championship and end with the 2010, Capital City Classic. Any player who placed in the top 10 from the 2009 Nevada State Amateur is automatically qualified for the 2010 Nevada State Amateur. The remaining top 10 from the points list are automatically qualified. The 30 qualifying spots are reduced for each exempt player. The State Amateur Qualifier Tournament will determine the remaining number of qualifiers. Qualifier entry fees must be submitted with the entry into the 2010 Northern Nevada Amateur. When successfully qualified, the balance will be due (see web site for dates). Exempt players must declare they will participate by June 14th. If you do not declare by June 14th your spot will go to the qualifier tournament. If fees are not paid by the deadline for both exempt and qualifying players the open spot will go to the next alternate.

State Mid-Amateur

Players will play without handicap (20 players from the north, 20 from the south): Points begin with the 2009 Masters 40 and end with the 2010 Northern Nevada Amateur. The top four finishers from the previous year are exempt also the remaining top 10 from the points list through the 2010 Northern Nevada Amateur. To be eligible you must be at least 25 years old by the first day of the tournament. There is no qualifier this year, non-exempt players will be accepted in order of receipt. ***If the tournament fills up priority will be given to lowest indexes.***

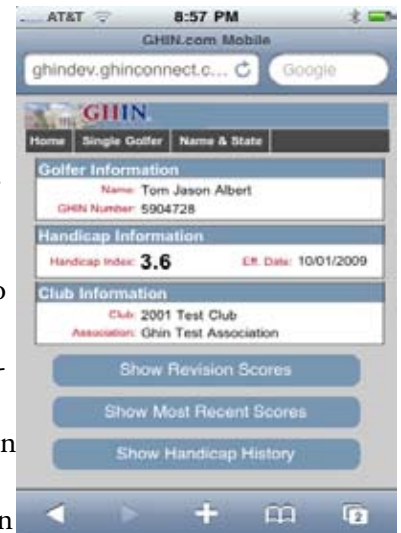
